FREE VIRTUAL OR IN SCHOOL WORKSHOP FOR STUDENTS IN YRS 9-13

Students will complete tasks in Gear Up workbooks to help them research information that is bespoke to their educational or career pathway. Due to Covid-19, we would prefer to deliver Gear Up virtually, however if this is not possible we are able to deliver Gear Up in school.



VIRTUAL WORKSHOP

- A pre-recorded video workshop delivered by a member of the Study Higher team
- We'll send you a box of resources before the workshop which will include student workbooks, a teacher guide and stationary
- Students will have interactive activities to complete throughout the session, some of which will be teacher-led
- The workshop can be delivered whenever suits you and lasts for a maximum of one hour

IN-SCHOOL WORKSHOP

- A one hour session that is delivered at your school by a member of the Study Higher team for a maximum of 30 students
- Can be repeated throughout the school timetable or be tailored to an individual school event
- Students will have interactive activities to complete throughout the session

STUDENTS WILL:

- Discover the various pathways to higher education, further education or employment.
- Research different careers and map out their own future.
- Explore apprenticeship opportunities in their area.
- Navigate useful websites for information specific to their career and educational pathways.
- Understand the differences between qualification levels.
- Gain an understanding of the benefits of apprenticeships and degree apprenticeships.

WHAT DO WE NEED?:

The workshop requires the students to use the internet so it will need to take place in a school computer room.
